- Peter late at school yesterday.

- I very tired this morning, but now I'm not.

- Jane and Mary at Paul's party last night.

- She with me this morning.

- There a lot of clouds in the sky yesterday.

- John and Sarah very bored last night.

- You at the supermarket yesterday afternoon.

- It very cold last week.

- My little brother very hungry yesterday.

- Today it's Sunday so yesterday Saturday.

- Where your mother yesterday?

- All the students very kind with me.

Past Simple - Verb To Be

- Complete with wasn't, or weren't.
 - I at school last night.
 - We hungry this morning.
 - They at home two hours ago.
 - Sam happy yesterday.
 - My friends here last month.
 - The dog in its house an hour ago.
 - It windy last week.
 - Mr. and Mrs. Red angry yesterday.
 - My dad very happy yesterday.
 - The exam as difficult as the last one.
 - Her toys modern at all.
 - Miriam my first love at school.
 - You in Italy last week.
 - The boys quiet.
 - They home for dinner.
