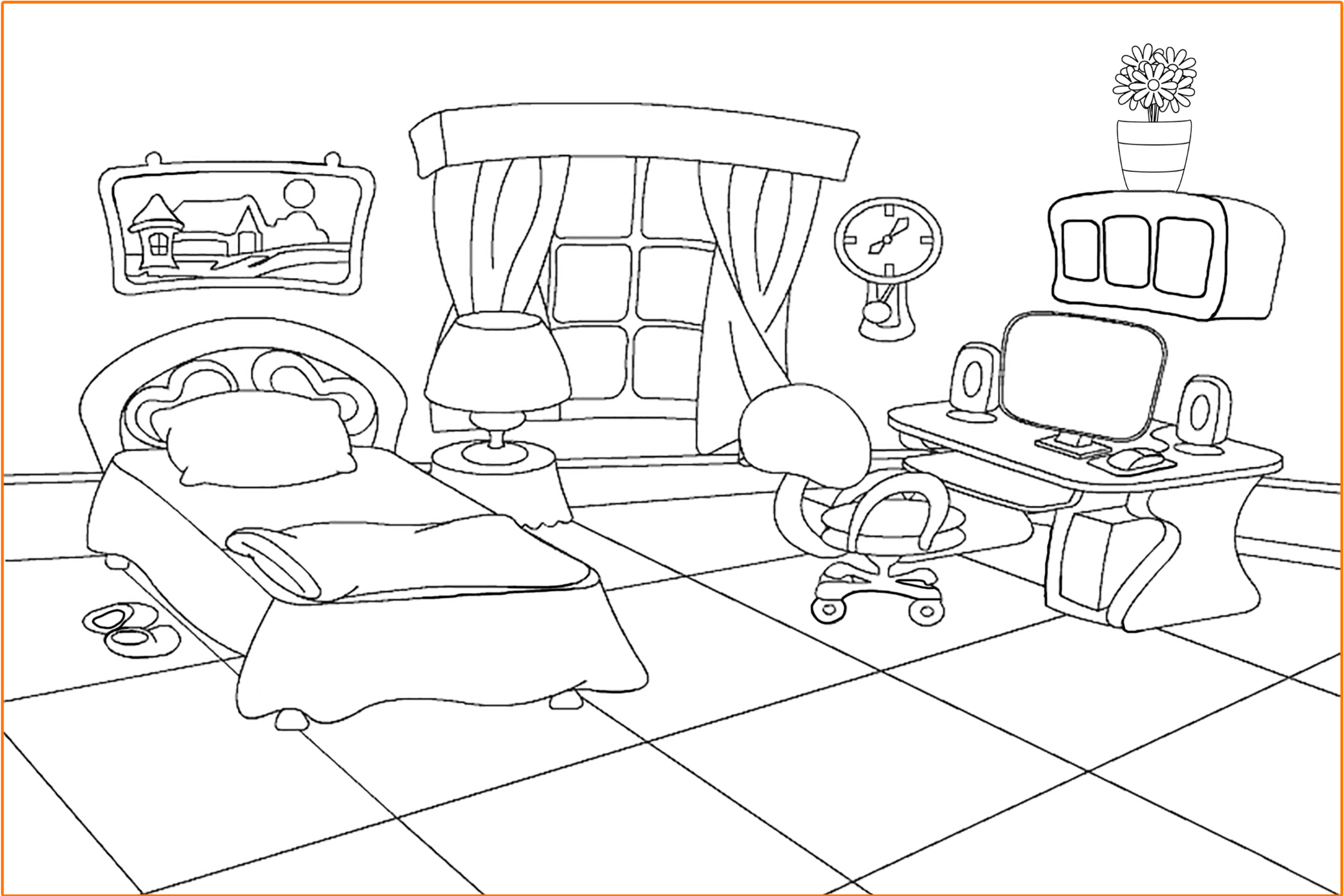


Prepositions of place

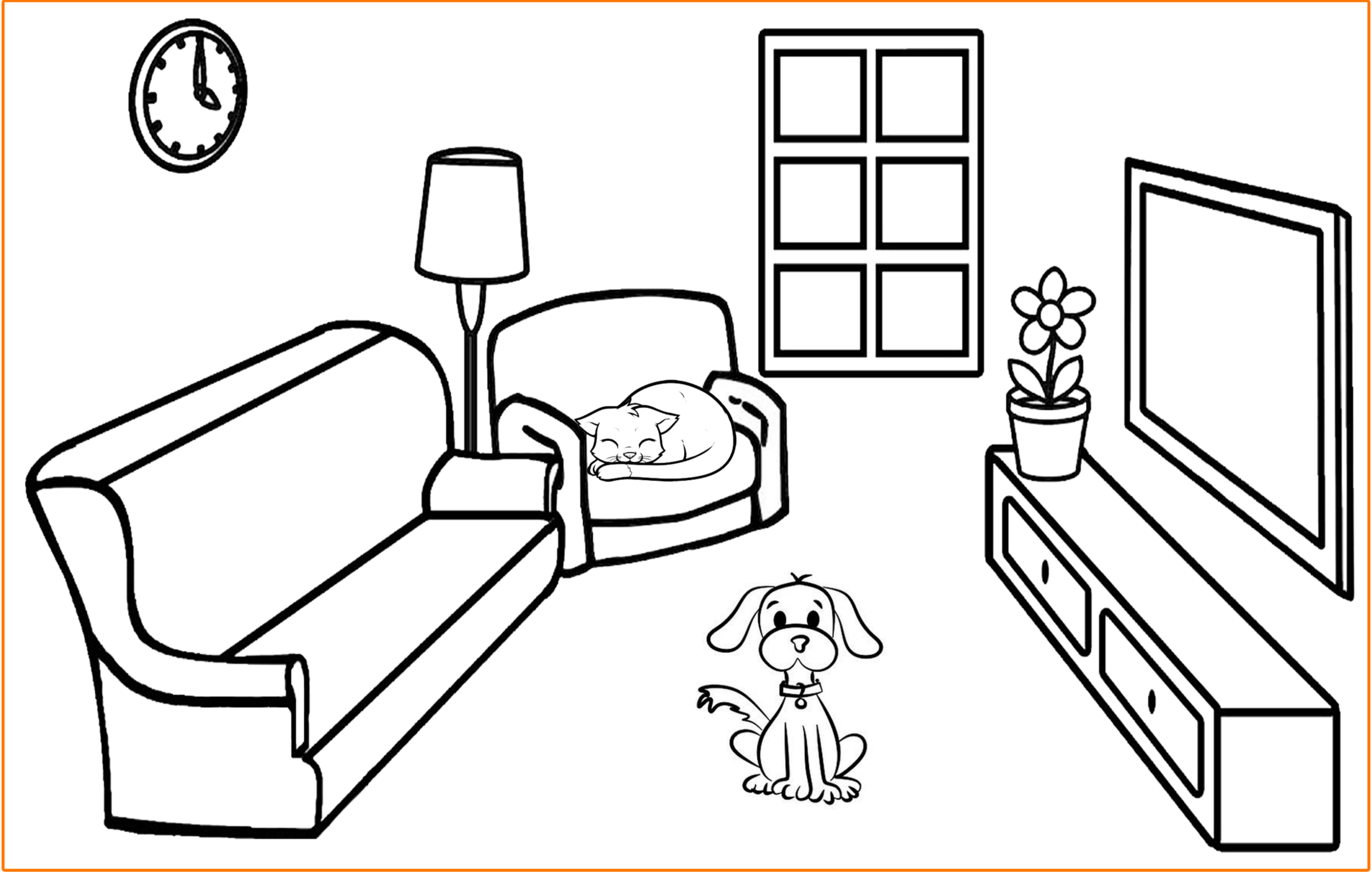
• Look at the picture and complete with in, on, under or between.

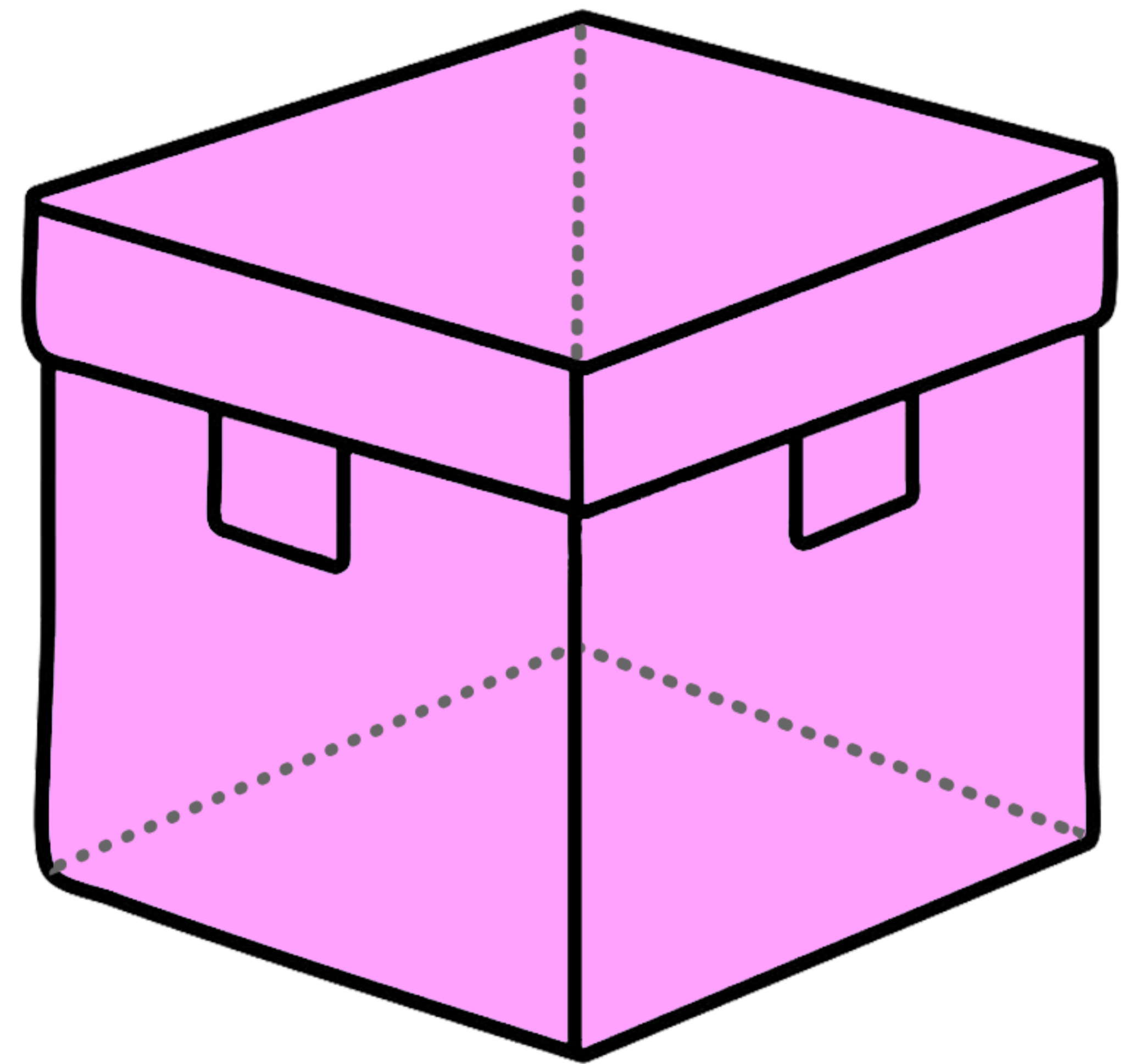
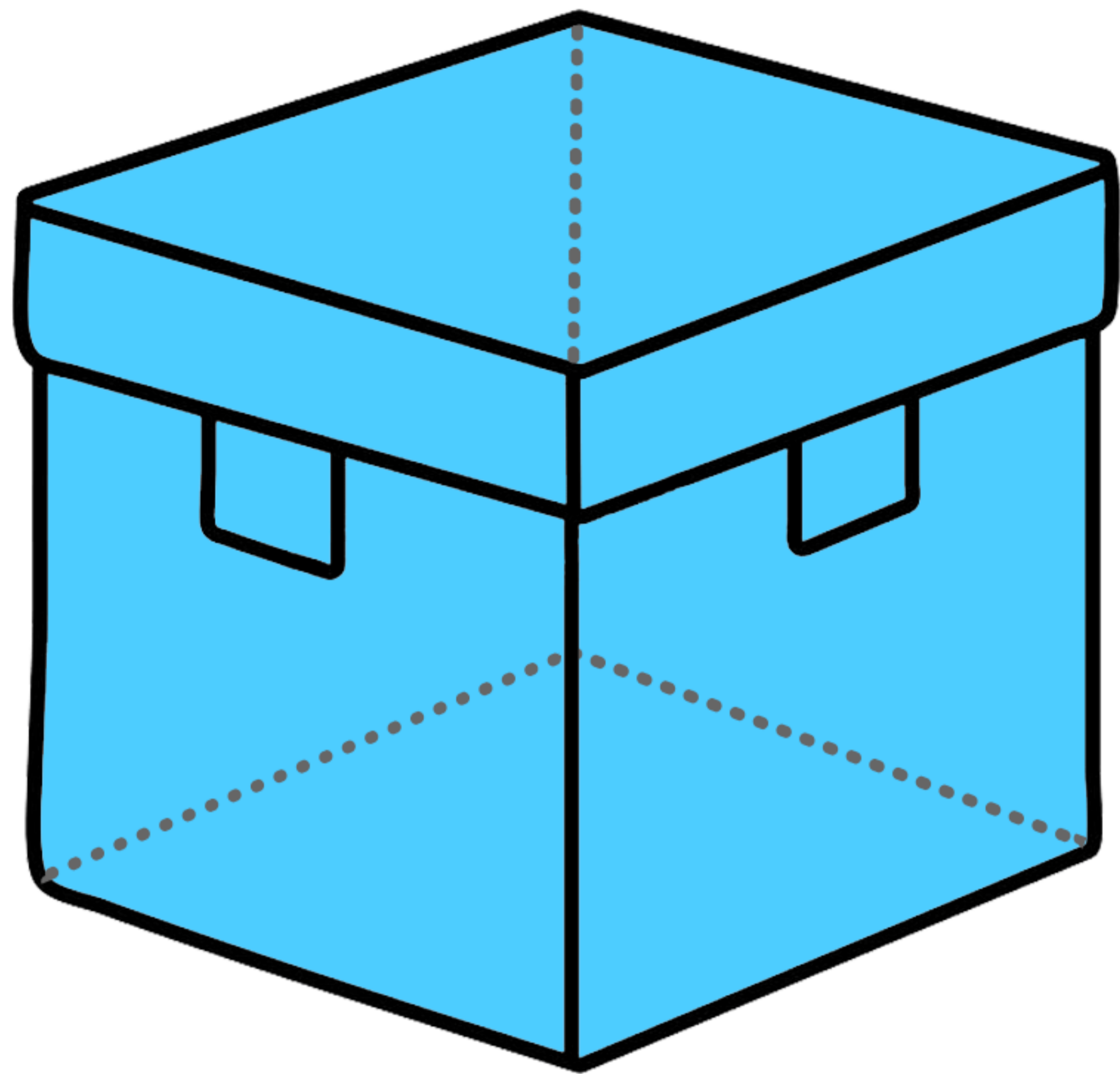
• Use prepositions of place (in, on, under, between, near) to answer the following questions:
